
HOW TO UPLOAD POSTS ON IN-HABIT'S WEBSITE


- The back office can be accessed by logging into the Reserved Area and then clicking on the 'W' (Wordpress) that you find in the top left corner of the page.
- Credentials will be given to all the KLC when the website goes online.







- Once in the back office, select Posts > All Posts, then hover over any existing title and select New Draft from the menu that appears under it.
- At the top of the list a duplicate will appear, labelled Draft. Click on the title or on Edit. The page that opens is already correctly set up, please do not change it.



- The first line is the title that will appear on the city page. Delete the old one and type in the new one. Repeat the same text on the line below.
- Right under the two titles, type in or copy and paste a brief description of the news/event.










- From the column on the right-hand side select Post from the menu at the top, then scroll down to Categories. Click on it and wait until the list appears. Select Cordoba or Cordoba events; Nitra or Nitra events; Lucca or Lucca events; Riga or Riga events, based on the type of post (news or event). The blog post will automatically be added to the right section. Please DO NOT add new categories.
- To add a photo, scroll further down and select Featured image; click on it and then click again on Replace Image. Drag and drop the chosen image or choose it from the existing library. Click on Set featured image.










- When the post is ready, click on Publish in the top right corner.
- Please always double-check that the post has been correctly added to the page before logging off.
- Whenever you make changes to the post, always remember to click on Update in the top right corner, so that the changes will be saved.
