Further co-design and co-deployment

Transformation of the outdoor marketplace

The first stage in transformation of the market square is finished. Currently KQ together with architects plan the second stage of transformation. Variety of activities take place in collaboration with a range of partners (e.g. Latvia State Forests, Bulduri Horticultural College, Riga Stradins University, Riga City Transport and Development Departments, Project CUPP).

Linked to WP6 Behavioural games.

Community kitchen

'Hard solutions' and procurement of equipment for the kitchen are delayed due to ammendment to the GA and shift of subcontracting from BSC to KQ. Instead, various 'soft' activities are taking place. This direction of work gradually embraces activities of Youth Station.


Minimisation of waste at the market

The IN-HUB conceives various new activities such as: eco-workshops, exchange points, charity shops, flea market

Online food purchasing system

This direction of work gradually embraces other forms of short supply chains at ĀM, e.g. establishment of farmer produce storage facility at the basement, help to farmers with logistics, facilitation of product labelling and other.




Public hearing process of **Riga Planning Region development documents**:
